- ◆ BOOTH SIZE ..... SINGLE: 10' front x 14' deep /  
DOUBLE: 24' front x 14' deep / TRIPLE: 38' front x 14' deep
- ◆ LOCATION..... Habert Park / Corner of 3rd & C Streets / Tehama, CA / 96090
- ◆ ENTRANCE..... **Habert Park gate entrance** is on the **cul-de-sac @ the North End of 4th Street** on the **WEST SIDE** of Habert Park.  
*FYI: 3rd Street will be barricaded for entertainment venue*
- ◆ SET-UP TIME..... From **7-9:00a.m.** / No late access permitted  
*A Pancake Breakfast will be served from 8a.m.-10a.m. - \$6.00*
- ◆ BOOTH SPACES..... Spaces are assigned / Rows are color coded / Spaces are numbered on "pin flags" at front of each booth.
- ◆ VEHICLES ..... Must be out of the Park by **9:00 a.m.**
- ◆ PARKING.....
  - Parking is available on the cul-de-sac end of 4th St. (see Map) / It's a Railroad easement - not paved / not mowed
  - A few parking spaces are on the apron of 4th Street - East side near the fence (see Map).
  - When these spaces are filled, please park away from Habert Park & the Museum on surface streets of Tehama - *we like to keep parking near event venues available for visitors.*
- ◆ POWER, WATER & PETS ..... NO Power or Water Available / NO Generators or Pets allowed
- ◆ CANOPY ..... NOT PROVIDED but **REQUIRED** - It's usually Sunny & Hot!
- ◆ TABLES & CHAIRS ..... NOT PROVIDED but recommended
- ◆ SMOKING / ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES...The Museum & Park are "Tobacco & Alcohol Free Zones"
- ◆ BOOTH FEE / RAFFLE DONATION.....Booth space fee: \$20.00 Single / \$35 Double / \$50 Triple  
**RAFFLE PRIZE DONATIONS from your booth inventory are on a voluntary basis - they are always most welcome but not required this year!**
- ◆ SODA / WATER / FOOD ITEMS / RAFFLE TICKETS / FUND RAISING / DONATIONS  
This is a fundraiser for the TCM. We will be the **only vendor** permitted to sell any beverages, food items (other than pre-approved, specialized ag products), Raffle Tickets OR to collect donations of any kind!
- ◆ BOOTH ITEMS.....**Acceptable:** Handmade craft items; original art (paintings, ceramics, etc.); jewelry; fabric items; pre-approved, local ag products; historical literature/items from local organizations, specialty retail vendor items, etc.  
**Unacceptable:** Manufactured / mass produced plaster & plastic "tchotchke" items, "garage sale" or "thrift store" items
- ◆ TEAR-DOWN TIME..... The event ends at **3p.m.** - that's the time to start tear-down!
