| BOOTH SPACES | Spaces are assigned / Rows are color coded / Spaces are numbered on "pin flags" at front of each booth. |

| PARKING | Parking is available on the cul-de-sac end of 4th St. (see Map) / It's a Railroad easement - not paved / not mowed A few parking spaces are on the apron of 4th Street - East side near the fence (see Map).
